Welcome to the Information and Library section of Hill Campus, Ranichauri. We aim to provide an inspiring information environment to deliver the best of services in support of the University's Mission to all students, faculty and staff of this campus.

About Us

The library and information unit of this campus closely supports education and research in the areas of Forestry, Horticulture and vegetable Sciences, Crop improvement, seed sciences, and other allied agricultural discipline. The library is housed in beautiful top floor of collage building and offers excellent environment for studies. It has great track record in providing quality information services to campus Community within our limited resources consisting of more than 20000 documents and e-resources. The library has the credit of being pioneer in introducing latest information technology to automate its services in the Tehri Garhwal region. The automation operation was initiated as early as in the year 1999.

Currently the entire learning resources of the library has been automated for electronic retrieval by creating an in-house database searchable through an OPAC . For better management of learning resources, increased security and control over inventory Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) a new generation of auto Identification and data automation process has been installed recently. We are proud of our innovation in service development and in delivering the best services information services driven by continuous improvement



Collection of Learning Resources

The library and information unit provides access to a fairly a good collection of more than 15500 learning resources including both print and e-resources consisting of most frequently used 10280 books, manuals and various types national and international reports. Besides special publications, back volumes of periodicals, audiovisual aids, E-thesis and important databases for research are also available . The library subscribes to more than 102 periodicals in print and databases like CAB Abstract, AGRIS , Indian Forester etc. These are accessible through a network of CD servers under a local area network. The library constantly updates and develops its collection on recommendations of faculty from time to time in areas of Forest sciences, Horticulture, Crop Improvement , Seed sciences, Vegetable Sciences and other allied disciplines of Hill Agriculture. It is also our Endeavour to procure all publications relating to Hill area development.

Online Public Access Catalogue

To supplement your learning whether you're looking for a book on your reading list, doing some wider reading or need some extra references to add to your essays, The best places to find relevant information is the catalogue. The library has automated all its resources and is searchable through simple search techniques. The OPAC will tell you what we have, whether it is available and where to find it

The OPAC and e-resources

The books and other learning resources are arranged using Dewey system of classification. Make sure that you note down the full class number or the call number before you look for them in shelves. Students may get more help in finding information by attending credit based information literacy course offered by the library.

Access and Membership

Access to all library and information resources is dependent on compliance with the rules and regulations of the university membership is open to staff and students currently employed by or registered at the university. Members of other institutions may use the facilities for reference, however, borrowing and inter library loan shall be limited to the terms of formal agreement with the authorities of both institutes

Arrangement for Loan

All staff and students must obtain a borrowers card from the circulation section of the library . The cards must be produced at the help desk for any loans that may be requested. It may also be noted that cards are non transferable and card holder shall be responsible for all items borrowed against the card

In order to obtain the card all staff and students are required to complete a registration form which is available at the help desk . Overdue charges at the rate of 0.50 Paisa shall be charged on each item/ learning resource kept beyond the period of loan. Reading materials can renewed for further period if not required by other readers. All users will have to return all items loaned on or before the due date . Journals , reference books and e-recourses are to be used in the library only and may not be borrowed. Users will have to pay the replacement cost of any item borrowed which is lost , stolen or damaged.

Library and Information Services

The library and information unit has the pleasure of providing the following services for its users.

Reference services

You may approach the Circulation and Help desk for any information or any assistance that you may require in use of learning resources and services. For specialized information need you may also contact the office-in -charge library. College of Forestry, Ranichauri.

Interlibrary loan

Inter library loan for books and periodicals not available in libraries holdings is made by procuring it from other neighboring universities and Institutes. The library in turn also lends its resources to other academic institutes . You may make a request in writing at the help desk.

E resource and Data bases searches.

CD based database searches can be made from the E- Resources section. The databases are mapped on CD server and accessible on all computer terminals . You may browse and also avail print outs at the rate of Rupee 1 per print page . Users from other institutes can also make use the facility at the rate of Rs 50/- as browsing charges , cost for print outs is additional. Besides, the section can also be used for accessing other online bibliographical databases and services like Open J-Gate, e-journals through CeRA, AgriCat etc

Text Book & Book Bank Services

The library maintains a separate collection of text books under book bank scheme . these are mostly prescribed text books recommended by the course instructors . The students can borrow up to 10 books for a period of an entire semester at the cost of Rs 10/- as rental charges .

Online Current Awareness Service

The members are informed about the new arrivals and learning resources through email.
In order to avail this service you may get your email address included at the help desk.
New additions are also displayed for a period of one week in the reading units of the Library .

Regulations, Conduct and safety

The members are strongly advised to take care of the following regulations governing the use of information resources. Access to all library and information services is dependent on compliance with the stated regulations.

1. Observe silence in the library premises and comply with the requirement of the designated area for Silent Study and quiet Group Study.
2. Talking on cell phones in side the library premises is highly discouraged. All mobile phones should either be switched off or switched to silent mode.
3. Smoking is strictly prohibited. Consumption of soft, hot or cold drinks is not permitted inside the reading units. However you may carry bottled water.
4. The Information and library Unit reserves the right to check bags, poly bags etc being taken through the exists if our staff has reasonable grounds to suspect an infringement. Users are requested to keep all their personal belongings near the exit gate counter.
5. No property facilitating the users should be damaged in any way. You will be required to pay for any kind of damage.
6. Any accidents or hazardous situation like fire, electric short circuit etc should be reported immediately to the staff.
